

## Title: Every Eye Shall See Him

What a glorious morning! Stay with Him. God is good. He is always good. I entitled this word, "Every Eye Shall See Him." These are some questions, "Does the Lord have the dominion within you?" ### Colossians 1:26-27 TPT

*There is a divine mystery—a secret surprise that has been concealed from the world for generations, but now it's being revealed, unfolded and manifested for every holy believer to experience. Living within you is the Christ who floods you with expectation of glory! This mystery of Christ, embedded within us, becomes a heavenly treasure chest of hope filled with the riches of glory for His people, and God wants everyone to know it.*

Amen. Does the Lord have dominion within you? This dominion is being revealed. His presence is being unfolded and is manifesting to every one of us. It is not just for that day. Right, it's daily. We have the opportunity daily to receive Him, to encounter Him and to know Him, because we go from glory to glory.

### Revelation 1:7 NKJV

*"Behold, He is coming with clouds, and every eye will see Him," and that means, 'every eye will see Him,' even they who pierced Him. And all the tribes of the earth will mourn because of Him. Even so, amen."*

We know and believe that the Lord is continually being revealed, and He comes to those who belong to Him by the spirit of wisdom and understanding and revelation. #### II Peter 1:16-18

A couple of Sundays ago I spoke on this. In review, at Jesus's water baptism, God Almighty, the Father, spoke out loud audibly for all to hear. *“This is my beloved Son. Listen to Him.”*

At His transfiguration when the glory of the Lord was manifested in front of Peter, James and John, all of Heaven, and two of those that came from Heaven. God said, *“This is My beloved Son in whom I am well pleased. He said, Hear Him.”*

John 12:27

Jesus prayed Himself, "Father, glorify Your name," then a voice came from Heaven, saying, "I have glorified it, and I will glorify it again." Hallelujah.

II Peter 1:16-18

When we talk about this, Peter says, "We were eyewitnesses of His majesty. For He received from God the Father, honor and glory," when the Father affirmed Him with His voice as to who He is, **before** He went to the cross. **Before** He went to the cross, to accomplish this work of the Kingdom of Heaven once and for all, **before** the resurrection. The Father spoke four times to Him, audibly. Affirming His majesty, affirming the glory, giving Him honor, as Jesus, the Son. Jesus prayed, "Father, glorify your name." II Peter 1:19 NKJV

II Peter 1:16-21 TPT

*"We were not retelling some masterfully crafted legend when we informed you of the power and the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ, for we saw His magnificence and splendor unveiled before our very eyes. Yes, Father God lavished upon Him radiant glory and honor when His distinct voice spoke out of the realm of majestic glory, endorsing Him with these words. This is my cherished son, marked by my love. All my delight is found in Him! And we ourselves heard that voice resound from the heavens like thunder while we were with Him on the holy mountain. And so we have been given the prophetic word—the written message of the prophets, made more reliable and fully validated by the confirming voice of God on the Mount of Transfiguration. And you will continue to do well if you stay focused on it. For this prophetic message is like a piercing light shining in a gloomy place until the dawning of a new day. When the morning star rises in your hearts.*

Verse 19, again, "And so we have been given the prophetic word—the written message of the prophets, made more reliable and fully validated by the confirming voice of God on the Mount of Transfiguration. And you will continue to do well, if you stay focused on it." That is that, "take heed and listen," right? "You will continue to do well if you stay focused on it." If you "stay focused on it." For this prophetic message is like a piercing light shining in a gloomy place until the dawning of a new day. When the morning star rises in your hearts. You must understand this at the outset. Interpretation of scriptural prophecy requires the Holy Spirit, for it does not originate from someone's own imagination. No true prophecy comes from human initiative, but is inspired by the moving of the Holy Spirit upon those who spoke the message that came from God." Hallelujah!

Ezekiel 12:1-2 NKJV

He was a prophet to Israel saying, *“which has eyes to see but does not see, ears to hear but does not hear; for they are a rebellious house.”* He shows the spirit of rebellion in *“eyes that are seen, but aren't seeing, ears of hearing, but not hearing, and to a heart that is not understanding.”* *The spirit of rebellion and divination.*

I Samuel 15:23 NKJV

It gets worse. Rebellion, witchcraft, stubbornness, pride, idolatry, anything else that has a dominion in us, that is blinding our understanding, our revelation knowledge, our ears, our eyes, our heart, to receive the prophetic word made more sure. Thus, we have to always come into repentance and pray to God that He would forgive us of these things. As a church body, pray for Him to forgive us of these things and take authority over them commanding them to leave in the name of Jesus. That is how you do that. You lay the axe to the root, pull it up and commanded to go. Then you must take heed and walk by the voice of the Spirit with Him every day. You have to fill your house with truth. You say, *“Well, it is easier said than done.”* But, by the Spirit of grace, He is right there with you. Because the goal is the Spirit wants the dominion.

When He has the dominion, you release your fear of going there with God. You know, when you release that fear of really letting God have it all.
