

Title: Rise-Divine Instruction and Inspiration

He is always working to bring us revelation knowledge of who He is. Jesus should be our magnificent obsession. Amen. I am going to review briefly the word last night on "Rise." He said, "Rise to the occasion, the "now" moment is set before you. Rise above chaos and confusion. Rise in biblical ascension. Rise mentally. His thoughts are higher than our thoughts. Rise to see that Magnificent Obsession. Rise in genius. Where you are strong you shall be stronger still. Amen. Rise in the extremes of brilliance of His light, His power, and of His glory. The higher you go, the more you see. The deeper you go, the more you understand. The wider you go, the more you see your own boundaries extend and expand. The further you go, you will gain strength, endurance, perseverance, and long-suffering. He said to go beyond the normal. No Limits.

There are no limits in God, in Christ Jesus, and His Kingdom. How far are you willing to go? Now, we say this over and over, "With God all things are possible." That is a "yes and amen." "With God, all things are possible." "Nothing is impossible for God," and you belong to God. In scripture it says, "We belong to God, in Christ; Christ belongs to God. In all things, He possesses all things." He is Creator God over all. We cannot lose. If you have been born again, we are in Him. He is in us and we are one. We are growing in the revelation knowledge. But, there is a call for us to come up, front and center and rise into the fullness of what He is calling us to, who He is in us, and for us to see Him in all of His glory. There are no limits in God.

He is not limiting you. It is the mind, our own stubborn will, our flesh and our mind that limits us. The enemy deceives us into thinking, "You just cannot do that. That is impossible for you. Maybe them or maybe your neighbor, but you cannot." There are no limits in God. He is perfect. He is the author and finisher of our faith. So we are supposed to be and walk limitless. Knowing that with God, all things are possible, and our tent pegs should be expanded even in our own mind. As we abide in the Word of God and the Holy Ghost, that is the work of the Spirit that joins us in our faith and opens up our understanding of God.

When we all first got born again, we only knew a few facts. That God was God Almighty. He was the Father of Jesus Christ and He made the way of salvation. Jesus Christ came into the world to save those who are lost and dead in their sin. He was crucified on the cross, dead and buried three days, then rose again from that grave. He ascended back to Heaven and is coming again. The great gospel of Jesus Christ is that God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him, shall not perish, but have everlasting life. This is truth. We all stepped into the Kingdom of Heaven by receiving this. We were limited in our own human reasoning and dead in our sin. The glory of God manifested as we saw Jesus, as we believed the Word. We believed in our heart, and confessed in our mouth that Jesus is Lord. Correct? There is no limit there, but we do not see exactly what we stepped into. We just thought we got saved and did not have to go to hell. Hallelujah! That is important.

The greater glory is that we stepped into God, and God stepped into us, in Christ Jesus. He wanted to put His Holy Spirit inside of us. That is amazing. Jesus said, "Repent, the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand. The Kingdom of Heaven has come near you. The Kingdom of God is like this. Seek first the Kingdom of God and His righteousness, and everything else will be added." There is this depth, and we just got born again. We did not exactly know and understand yet, who our Father was or who Jesus really is, or Holy Spirit. But, our spirit man has been born again from above now, and is able to receive Heaven's instruction and Heaven's revelation.

Our spirit was once dead and now it is alive. That is why wisdom and revelation “kissed” and came together, and opened up from that day forward for us to continue to grow in the knowledge of Jesus Christ. Here you are today. Maybe you just got saved last week. Hallelujah. The journey has just begun. But, you understand, “Oh to know the depth, the length, the width and the breadth of the love of God.” So, we are all rising. We are rising. We are growing. There are no limits with God. I do not want to limit Him. I do not want to limit Him with my mouth. Because, there is power. “Life and death are in the power of the tongue.” If you have a test set before you, and say, “I am probably going to fail it.” Well, you are already toast, right? He says, “You have to get some strong faith here, because that is going to be a hard test. “Surely, I shall pass this test. In Jesus name, because the Lord has strengthened me.” It is that simplicity.

Yet, there is so much glory in this knowledge that God is limitless. There are no limits. God said, “How far do you want to go? How much do you want? How much of God do you want to really know? How do you want to know? Do you want to know? Do you want to tangibly encounter Him? Do you want to feel Him? Do you want to smell Him? Do you want to encounter His presence? He is real. The Word of God was made manifest. This Bible is the inspired Word of God, and the story of mankind from the beginning to the very end, and we are in it. Say, “I am in it.” He is with us, and we shall finish well, in Jesus’s name.

The word of God came last night in the psalmist prophetic ministry, and Brent brought it up again. We were worshiping the Lion of the tribe of Judah, which is the tribe of Israel that Jesus’s lineage came through. Jesus is known as the Lion of the tribe of Judah. The Lord said, “I have made up my mind about you. Have you made up your mind about me? Settle it.” “I have made up my mind about you. We sang about it all morning long. “I am convinced that God is with me. God is with me. Even through the fire, and even through the flood, God is with me. “Christ in me the hope of glory.” “I have made up my mind about you. Have you made up your mind about me? Settle it.” God says that often. When He says, “Settle it.” I know exactly what He means. That means I will not go back on my word. He has given His word to me. I have given my word to Him. “How can two walk together unless they be in agreement?” He is a “yes and amen.” But, He asks of us to say, “Yes, amen. So be it, settled.”

God Almighty works it out. Thank the Lord that we are not in charge of that. Aren't you glad you are not God? Thank you, Jesus. We are not God. Aren't you glad? You think, “I have enough on my plate. I sure do not need to deal with the world, much less the millennial reign.” He is so great. “My God is so big, so strong and so mighty. There is nothing my God cannot do,” is an old children’s song. That was revelation knowledge. Right? He said, “I have made up my mind about you. Have you made up your mind about me? Settle it. Take up your authority and look in my eyes. I am faithful and true. I have made up my mind about you. You make up your mind about me.” This is going to ring in our ears and heart all year long and for all eternity. He chose us. He chose you. Mankind can reject us, but He has chosen us. Hallelujah!

Deuteronomy 33:27

That was part of what Debra was prophesying this morning. “Many are those who are against me. But, You oh Lord, hold the victory.” Amen. “The eternal God is your refuge. The everlasting God is our refuge, and underneath are the everlasting arms.” That is personal. It is one thing to have this eternal God that is up there somewhere, almighty and overseeing everything. “Woe is me, for I am undone.”

We are the sheep of His pasture. We are His flock. Jesus is the Great Shepherd. He leads us into all truth. Though so much trouble in this world can come, the Lord is my shepherd. I shall not want. The eternal God is your refuge, and underneath are the everlasting arms. "He will thrust out the enemy from before you, and will say destroy."

Jude 1:24-25 NKJV

That was not just a good ending to the story of Jude's letter. It is an inspiration from the Holy Ghost who was giving God praise. The man of God penned it and partnered with it and saw the glory. You hear this? "Now to Him who is able to keep us from stumbling and to present us faultless." Faultless, thank you, Jesus, for the blood. Forgiven means forgiven, but some have been tormented from the sins of their past even after they get saved. They are still in torment. We must receive the forgiveness. That takes humility. It takes such grace and love to know that we have been forgiven. "He will present us faultless before the presence of His glory," because no man can stand before Him and live.

Jude 1:25

That is the shalom of God. It is the perfect peace. It is a wholeness. It is a sound mind. Divine insight, according to His Word, keeps us in the pure way of God. Divine insight. There are times when the Body of

Seek His face, and look into the matter at hand, for insight from Heaven. Daily, God's Word is ministering to every saint His way and His Word, daily. Say, "today." You say, "Well, I did not know that, I just got up." He has been ministering to you 24/7. He has been ministering to you while you sleep. He gives to His Beloved even in our sleep. Thank the Lord. I am just saying. Sometimes you wake up, and think what did we talk about last night, Lord? Was I here or there? Did You walk in my room last night, Lord? Something is different? Do not limit God. We have a daddy here with a baby who will not sleep. He ministers to us in our sleep, even when we are up with the baby. I have been there and done that a few times. He ministers and He is always speaking. Some of my greatest victories have been at night with a nursing baby, and declaring the victory in warfare as I walk them around the room. Amen.

Wow, God's word is ministering to every saint His way. You just have the knowing on the way to go. You just understand all of a sudden, He said, "Let me teach you my ways." Yes. God is daily ministering. Say it. "He doesn't skip a beat. He did not skip a day. Well, that was a dark day from hell, but He was there." Even when we were rebelling and rejected Him, He was there.
