Well, good to see everybody. Praise God, it is a glorious night tonight. All weekend, it will be continue to be glorious. Every time we gather in the name of Jesus, I always exhort the Body to come expectant. If you are online and listening to this again, always be expectant of the Lord. I think that He is worthy of that. He is worthy of our expectancy. Just to believe Him and to take Him at His word. Look to Him, and exalt Him for who really He is. As the body, we want to always live that way. To us it is a lifestyle isn't it? Every time we gather in Jesus name I am always exalting Him. I really want to magnify Him. He is magnified. Psalms 1 NKJV

Praise God. Psalm 1 is very clear, our delight is in God and in His Word. It is talking about abiding in the Lord and His word. It is a lifestyle. We have to understand that God has the preeminence. You must lay hold of this no matter what. God has the preeminence. You just wake up knowing it, you smell it, you hear it, you breathe it, and you are confident of it. God has the preeminence in all things. He wants to have preeminence in our life. This Psalm is going to this, it is pointing to this. For those who are right in Him, He has the preeminence. Our whole heart is given over to His word. It's out of relationship.

Psalms 1:3 NKJV

His delight is in the Word of God. The righteous man's delight is in the heart of God. Our delight is in the word of the Lord, and Jesus is the Word. Our delight as believers is in God. Our passion is His Word. His Word is our food, our meat, our will, our life. Because of this, "we shall be like a tree planted by rivers of water, that brings forth its fruit." "Whose leaves shall not wither and whatever he does." That is a whatever. I always tell people, if it says whatever in the word, you know that it means "**whatever**." Whatever you do, shall prosper when you are planted and rooted in His Word, not religion. Not, "you have to," because it is January and you have to do that whole Bible reading plan. But, because you **want** to be in His Word. This is a promise to prosper here in this scripture. According to the Strong's, it means to "advance." "Whatever He does shall prosper." That means, we shall advance. We shall make progress. We shall succeed. We will be profitable. We will push forward. We will break out. Come mightily, come over, be good, and sent out. "Whatever he does shall prosper." That is what this word entails. The Word of God is our final authority. God wants us to be full. Amen? God hates lack. God wants us to flourish. God wants us to prosper in who He is. I don't want to prosper in who I am. I don't want to prosper in who my neighbor is. I want to prosper in who He is. If He said that He is loyal, then I want to prosper in His loyalty. He is emphasizing, "I am loyal. Be loyal as I am loyal." Then, I want to succeed. I want to press through here. I want to break out and be loyal. He wants us to prosper in who He is. Everything is about Him.

Ephesians 2:6

This is a reality.

Galatians 2:20

This is our reality. It is a reality that we have been translated out of darkness and into His light. Out of the kingdom of darkness and into the light and the kingdom of the Son. Right now, seated with Him in heavenly places. Right now. So, every morning when you wake up, "I take my seat. I choose it. I believe it. I am seated with you in heavenly places. I am with you. He is passionate about a lot. God wants relationship. That is who we are walking with here. So it is all about Him.

John 15

We read it all the time. We know that our desire is that we bear much fruit for our Father. Our goal is to bear much fruit for our Father. That was Jesus's goal and heart's desire, so that must be mine. I want to bear much fruit. I want to be like Him. I want to bear much fruit. When we abide and remain in the Lord and His word, we will bear fruit. It's impossible not to bear fruit, if you are abiding in Him. If your delight is in Him, you will bear fruit. You will prosper. We are living rivers and wherever we go, life happens. You have to know, wherever we are, life just came in to the room. No matter what is there. Wherever we go, life happens. Even when you go to sleep at night. Even when you wake up in the morning. I don't know, but wherever we go, life happens. Life happens. Say, "life happens. Wherever I go, wherever I am, life happens."

Now we have to remember we are His rivers. We are flourishing ones. Why are we flourishing? Because our delight is in Him. Our delight is in the law of the Lord. Our delight, our passion, our heartbeat, our life is Him, and all that He is. We are His flourishing ones. We are His witnesses to every people, tribe, tongue and nation. We must choose this day whom we will serve. Jesus is preparing His church, He is leading His church, and He is bringing unity within His church right now. I have stated this.

It is amazing, and I am astounded at what the Spirit of the Sovereign Lord is doing. He is moving in every dream, vision, impression, word, unction, every movement, all conviction, and answered prayer. Everything that He is giving you, foreknowledge and where you are going, is all from the Holy Ghost. He is moving. He is bringing a unity of the Spirit like we have never seen. That excites me. I have been around the church world awhile. It excites me, because it is not a false unity. It is a real unity of the Spirit. Only God can birth this and it is happening. God is laboring with the church to bring true justice and righteousness. He is laboring with the church to bring true justice and righteousness. He has blessed us in Christ. We are flourishing. There is no limitation in Christ, of how much you can know Him on this side of glory. Don't let anyone ever tell you that there is a cap. Don't let anyone restrain you. Don't let anybody hold you back from seeking His face. Don't think, "Well that is just for the other side in heaven." Jesus prayed, "Father, Your kingdom come and Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven." So don't wait for heaven to encounter Him. "Well, when I get the glory." I want to see His glory here *on earth*. I want to know Him the way I am going to know Him, now. I don't want to wait! That is what is going to bring Him back. Because, the Bride is saying, "I don't want to wait anymore." You understand? It is a jealous heart that beats for His. This is truth. He has blessed us. Wake up every morning and say, "I am here to exalt you. I am here to magnify you." Before you get off that bed, give Him praise. Jesus died for our freedom. He died for our freedom. Galatians 5:1, "It was for freedom that Christ set us free." So there is no lid there. There is no end there. Freedom will continue.

The Holy Spirit says spread out your wings and fly. He tells us to soar. No turkeys or chickens. He told us to fly like eagles. Rise up, spread your wings, fly, and soar. I want to soar with God. You know what that looks like, right? Well, He is saying He wants us to soar and fly with Him, just as eagles fly.

We know that the United States of America is called to host the liberty, in order to worship God. We know that the United States of America is going through four years of very deep cleansing. Praise the Lord, that is an understatement. We know that He who has began a good work in us is able to complete it. God is able. God is able, He has the preeminence. Praise God.

In December 2018, we know the prophecy of from Rick Joyner, through the Spirit of God, that the second American Revolutionary civil war is inevitable. It says, it is right and it will be successful. I am pointing everybody to it and it shall be successful. If God says it is going to take place, it is taking place, it is right. That means God knows it is going down. He is working on something, and it shall be successful. You have to keep that in mind, that God's purging, God's refining, God's *calling to repentance*, God's cleansing. Notice, I am putting this on God. It is successful, not man's ways. Say, "God is successful." We know that only King Jesus will finish His work on Earth. Now, when He says Jesus is the Branch, that is going to tie you right back to flourishing. All right. Jesus is the Branch and He is the Desire of the Nations. Jesus has already multiplied Himself. Wow, the synergy of the ages. God's people are serving Him in their own generation. Since Jesus, He has multiplied Himself. He is flourishing to this day. Look at us. We are still alive and breathing. All right, and generation after generation, to those who have been called by His name, are taking His word, and by His Spirit are continuing on. We are caught up in the Hebrews 11 group. Right in the synergy of the ages to complete what God is doing. He will complete it. Jesus has multiplied Himself.

Genesis 1:26-28

This is the original blessing, you know this to be true. God said, "Now, let's bless them." The blessing of the Lord. It is the blessing of the Lord that makes us rich. He adds no sorrow to it. It is in His blessing, where we flourish. We are blessed, therefore, we flourish. Therefore, we bear fruit. We are blessed, therefore, we multiply Jesus in our lives. Flourish, in the Strong's, actually means, "to bud, to sprout, to break out, to fly, to send out shoots, blossom, grow, break forth, spread out, spring up, and spread. So if He says, 2021 is the year to flourish, we are already flourishing. So my goodness, "bud, sprout, breakout, fly, send out shoots, blossom, grow, break forth, spread out, spring up, and spread." I told you, He desires that we bear much fruit for the Father. In the dictionary, "flourish means a vigorous state, to be in one's prime, successful, to prosper, to grow, to thrive in growth." Amen! We thrive in growth. We thrive and increase. We thrive when we are growing in God. See, there is no religion in what I am saying. There is nothing restraining in what I am saying. It is His word.

On January 3. of this year. Robin Harman gave the word on “Flourishing in Peace and Triumph.” The year 2021, itself means it is “as a weapon of war, a sharp or strong weapon of war.” Welcome to 2021. You wonder why the intercession is increasing. The Hebrew year is 5781, and as she broke it down, the review is that we must understand, it is going to be the “year of the mouth, of the eye and window” to look into, to reveal. That refers to Revelation being revealed, “of the plow and the weapon.” Put your hand to the plow, “for the weapons of our warfare are not carnal.” All right, a fence of separation, what God is doing. “Choose you this day whom you will serve.” The strength of your leader, Jesus, the mouth, to speak out of the mouth, “There shall be miracles.” One of the times I woke up in the middle of night, I woke up and I was speaking out of my mouth, “there shall be miracles.” You see, Jesus is doing a wonderful work. He knows what He is doing. Our speech, our word, our vocalization, our expression, our face, presence. We will all have fresh fire. Everything we look at in Jesus is going to be reflected through us.

This is the Lord's blessing. We want His face. We want to see His face. Show me your glory. I want to know Jesus. There is a visible change in our countenance when we seek His face. If He is glowing, I am glowing. God's face lights up when we spend time with Him. His countenance is cast upon us. Peace comes in His countenance and His presence. It's the shalom of God. The realm where chaos is not allowed to enter. We are flourishing in His presence. Peace is completeness, success, fulfillment, wholeness, harmony, well being, and security. See, it is a good thing to have this Psalms 1, thing going down. All of this stuff, because you know Him, you are abiding in Him and His word. He is your delight.

Psalms 121 NKJV

The Lord is our keeper. The Lord is your shade at your right hand. The sun shall not strike you by day, nor moon by night. The Lord shall preserve you from all evil. He shall preserve your soul. The Lord shall preserve your going out and your coming in, from this time forth and forevermore. The glory of the Lord shall be revealed. That is what I am after. That is what I am looking for Him. All the flesh shall see it together because the mouth of the Lord is spoken. Praise God. We will see and know the strength of our God. We will see like never before until the coming of Jesus and afterwards how strong and mighty and valiant how magnificent He is. God Almighty, our God, the awesome God, the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, is our God.

Praise the Lord. The Lord our God is in our midst. He is the Mighty One and He will save. He will rejoice over us with gladness. He will quiet us with His love. He will rejoice over you with singing. He never gives up. He is happy about us. Finally, brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power and strength of His might. Remember to keep the whole armor of God on that we would be able to stand against all the wiles of the devil. We are called to flourish in His peace. Because we are doing that, we can now say, "thanks be to God who always leads us in triumph in Christ." I am just saying. There is no defeat in Him. There is no failure in Him. Thanks be to God who always leads us in triumph in Christ, and through us He diffuses the fragrance of His knowledge in every place. I told you, wherever you go, life happens. That is the fragrance of His presence. That is what it says. "Wherever we go, the fragrance of His presence will come into those places."

So I want you to be encouraged with that and and for those who have not heard these or been there. On our website, you can go to those dates and look at the messages and listen to them again. Get it in you. Let the Holy Ghost lead.

Now, I am very attentive to the order of things and how God brings things. In the middle of the "Flourishing" word, He calls the Church of God back to the table of the Lord. I give ear to what God says and how He says it, and when He says it. He is a builder. I give note to what word is coming when it comes. He gave out a tremendous call one morning prophetically "to return to the table of the Lord." That doesn't just mean, "well make sure you take communion every day." It is "return to His table, His mission, His body, His purpose, His heart, His blood, the finished work of the Cross. Return Body of Christ to Jesus, to the table of the Lord. Those who are blessed are planted in the house of the Lord. You are planted in Him. You are deeply rooted in Him. He gave out a tremendous call to, "Return, return, return to the table of the Lord." You know God is hospitable. All through Scripture you will see they are always eating bread and drinking wine. They are always having feasts. God loves it. He is a Father. He loves this table. Isn't it beautiful? We call it the Last Supper, where Jesus invited His disciples to have Passover together. Then that is where He revealed Himself and broke the bread. He gave the cup. The unity of the Spirit began there, out of His body and out of the blood that was coming to be shed. "Return to the table of the Lord. Return to the table." This is what He cries out, and He calls us, and says we are flourishing.

It continues on then with you will have to “apply.” You have to apply wisdom. You will have to apply knowledge. You are going to have to apply yourself to what God is saying. He is going to give you details. He is going to give you personal instruction. He is going to teach you if you will give yourself to Him. If you will attend to His word, He will continue to lead us in the way.

I want to read to you from what Holy Spirit has compiled for you. “Flourish in 2021,” I have been saying “it is a new God year.” You just have to pay attention to what comes out of your mouth. It is a new God year. That means God is going to be glorified in it like never before. 2021 is a new God year and all we know is that, “Who is like our God? Who is like our God? Who is like our God?” May we all say, “who is like our God? Show off, God, show yourself so strong. We are looking for you. We want God, we want God, we want God.” Right? That is what this looks like. “Who is like our God?” I want that to be our boast. I don't want anything *else* to be my boast. I am not going to glorify trash. I am not going to glorify the lies. I am not going to glorify the evil. I am going to glorify God. I am going to say, “who is like our God?”

So, these are the words from Jesus to His beloved, “Behold I will make all things new. Will you believe it? Will you receive my good will and desire for you? Will you open your heart to me as never before? Will you lean into, and upon my chest and hear my heart and desire and know and trust me, as never before? It always starts here. Here with me. You and me together, here in the quiet place of our soul. You are the one who perseveres to the saving of the soul. You shall not draw back. You shall not relinquish your rights. You shall overcome through my grace, blood, strength, joy, and confident assurance of my Father's will. You are one with me and in me. I am with you always, even to the end of the age. Let's run this race together this year, as you join with me and my Father, in accomplishing another revelation of our mission to save. I am truth. You are lovers of truth. My Word is truth. You are convinced of the truth. Your truth has set you free. You have truth. The truth you know has set you free. Abide and remain in my truth. Persevere, persevere, persevere, in truth. We are lovers of truth. You are not given over to any delusion, or discrepancy. But you are sure, sound footed, well grounded, confident, assured, safe, secure, kept, empowered, joined as one, as one, as one, as one in my love, my way, my word, and my truth. The heavens are open to you through my blood, will, and flesh. You are bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh. You and me together forever, our heart one heart, our mission one mission, our purpose one purpose, and one way.

Join me now in this harvest. I see where you have sown. I hear your prayers, and I have been with you through it all. I have never left you, and I never will. You are invincible in me and with me. I am sustaining you with the will to persevere, to rejoice and save to the preserving of the soul. Holy Spirit's desire is to comfort you as never before. Allow the blanket of His comfort, His glory presence, to sustain and heal you, deliver you, warm you, heal you, and restore you. I am with you to sustain you. I am yours and you are mine, Beloved. Great comfort. Comfort, comfort, comfort, my people. You are noble. You are noble, my Bride. You are my Regency, my One, my All. Join my heart in nobility and grace. Walk with your head lifted up and turn towards me. My countenance will flood your face, heart, soul, mind, will and body with so much power, nobility, grace and anointing, and most importantly, a surrender to the heart of our Father. Look at me. Look to me. Do not turn aside. Look straight ahead. I am your vision. I am your kingdom vision. I am your place of no return. We have gone past the point of no return. We are one. I will not relax my hold on you,

ever. I am the same yesterday, today, and forever. I love you. You will have vision from this observatory, my holy hill, my counsel. You will see with a whole new perspective and grace to lead many to my chambers of grace. It is in my chambers that I call others to myself as King, Lawgiver, and Judge. I am the counsel of God. I am true justice, and I am the answer. I am expanding your borders, your will, your heart, your thoughts and your spirit to mine. I am delivering you from your human reasoning and limitations. Oh Beloved, look closely, but look closer still. Do you see me? Do you see me? Do you feel me? I am your great Shepherd, the Lover of your soul. Tonight, I reveal my love to you again, as your Savior and great Lover of your soul. You shall flourish with me and in me. But, apart from me you can do nothing. Go deep and higher at the same time as you surrender all to me. There is no turning back. Only forward movement in my Father's kingdom. You believe well, I call you lovers of truth. All I could hear out of that vision was "comfort, comfort, comfort, my people. Holy Spirit is your Comforter. That is what the scripture says, "Holy Spirit is our Comforter." So take comfort.
