You must have my goodness in the land of the living. My goodness is my glory. But you cannot behold my goodness, unless you know the Fear of holiness. Unless My Fear, is revered.

Indeed, "I would have lost heart, unless I had believed that I would see the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living. (Psm 27:13) and "you will say, "(The branches of Israel) were broken off so I might be grafted in (to the goodness of God). That is true. Well said, they were broken off because of their unbelief, but you, stand fast through faith. Do not be haughty, but fear." (Rom 11:19–20) Do not be proud, Fear! My Fear, is to be revered. "For If (He) did not spare the natural branches (of His people) He may not spare you either. Therefore, consider the goodness and severity of God: (first) on those who fell, severity; but (now) toward you, goodness of God. (that is) if you continue in His goodness. Otherwise, you also will be cut off." (Rom 11: 21–22) Consider, "…even now the ax is laid to the root of the trees. Therefore every tree which does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire… His winnowing fork is in His hand, and He will thoroughly clean out His threshing floor…" (Matt 3:10,12)

Consider the goodness and severity in the hand of the Lord. You must have His goodness, yes. But you must know His fear. The Fear of His Holiness. The Fear of His Spirit. Revered. Honored. Severity, sought after.

"For the commandment of the Lord is pure, enlightening the eyes;

The fear of the Lord is clean, enduring forever;

The judgments of the Lord are true and righteous altogether." (Psm 19:8-9)

"For **who** may ascend unto the hill of the Lord? **Who** may stand in My Holy place? Is it not he who has clean hands and a pure heart?" (Psm 27:3) What is clean, son? The fear of the Lord. What is pure, daughter? My commandment. Let Me enlighten your eyes. Let me "strengthen the hands which hand down, and strengthen your weak knees (to stand in my Holy Place!) make straight paths for your feet so that what is lame may not be dislocated, but rather be healed." (Heb 12:12-13) Be healed. Be healed! "Pursue peace with all people, and (pursue) holiness. Without (holiness) no one will see the Lord." (Heb 12:14) Without My Holiness, none of you will see the Lord. Read the Word! Let My commandment enlighten you. HOLINESS NOW! Without Holiness you will not see the Lord. Revere the Spirit of the Fear of the Lord! My winnowing fork is in My hand. It is the (S)-Word of the Lord!

"Do you not know that if you present yourselves to anyone as obedient slaves, you are slaves of the one whom you obey?" (Rom 6:16) Whom are you presenting yourself to? What are you presenting your eyes to? I see. And My Name is Jealous. You either present yourselves to "sin, which leads to death, or (present yourself) of obedience, which leads to righteousness? But thanks be to God, that you who were once slaves of sin have become obedient from the heart to the standard of teaching to which you were committed, and, having been set free from sin, have become slaves of righteousness." I have high hopes for you, My Garden. I have committed to you My daughter, listen to her! Listen to her standard of teaching. Recommit. Recommit to the standard of doctrine I need from you. You are not like the rest of My Body. You are unique. I need you connected to My body, yet unique. "...indeed there are many members, yet one body. And the eye cannot say to the hand, 'I have no need of you' nor again the head to the feet, 'I have no need of you.' No, much rather, those members of the body which seem weaker are necessary." (1 Cor 12:20-22) You are necessary. You see yourself as weak. Connect yourself to your apostle's standard and strengthen your weak knees to stand; to be courageous; to fulfill your ministry to Me. This is my daughter. Listen to her!

"I am speaking in human terms because of the weakness of your flesh. For just as you presented your members as slaves of uncleanness, and of lawlessness leading to more lawlessness, so NOW, present your members as slaves of righteousness, for HOLINESS." (Rom 6:19) Present yourselves, for HOLINESS, NOW! Present yourselves, for HOLINESS, NOW!

"..NOW, NOW, NOW that you have been set free from sin and have become slaves of God, the fruit you get leads to HOLINESS, and in the end, everlasting life."

Amen, Jesus. Let it be done according to Your Word. I honor this word form the Lord.
